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## Riesling & Grüner Veltliner

*Riesling is undoubtedly one of the great wine grapes of the world. It offers excellent value for money, speaks of place and vintage and only gets better with age. While styles and levels of residual sugar can vary significantly, when made well, the acid in the wine should balance this, meaning that it still finishes bright, fresh and clean.*

## Pinot Grigio, Gris & Blanc

*These cousins of the Pinot Noir grape all produce lovely refreshing white wines. While Gris and Grigio are produced from the same grape, it is more than just the translation that distinguishes the two - Gris tends to be a larger, richer wine made from riper grapes that gives it a more tropical flavour, whereas the lighter Grigio offers a nice balance of fruit, minerality and vibrancy with more citrus notes, whilst Pinot Blanc/Bianco is lighter and crisper again.*

## Skin Contact & Minimal Intervention Wines

At CWR we take umbrage at the use of the phrase 'natural wines' to depict some new form of viticulture or winemaking that is inherently more 'natural' than the traditional wines on our list. We reckon most wines on our list are pretty natural, with many organic and biodynamic producers making great wines that do not need a trendy new phrase to define them. That being said, we also recognise that there are some great winemakers out there who are adopting biodynamic practices in their vineyards to minimise the chemicals used in the grape growing process, making wine with as little human and/or technological intervention as possible - often taking their inspiration from historic viticulture and winemaking techniques to apply in the modern world, experimenting with extensive skin contact, minimal filtration, carbonic maceration etc. In the collection below, we seek to offer a neat little collection of interesting wines for those looking to push the boundaries -nothing too crazy, but definitely interesting.

*Nebbiolo is the classic red grape from the Piedmont region of Italy that has a long history of producing some of the finest wines in the world. ## Sangiovese

Alongside Nebbiolo, Sangiovese is the other iconic red wine grape of Italy. Produced primarily in Tuscany, Sangiovese wines express themselves through wonderful delicacy, primarily red fruit flavours like red cherry, strawberry, plum, balanced out with savoury flavours like clove, earthiness, smoke, complemented by nice levels of acid and relatively low levels of tannin. However, terroir and winemaking are all important, as you will learn from the great diversity of wines in the list below.

The expression of Sangiovese grown around Montalcino is the most powerful of the various clones, and it produces the magnificent Brunello di Montalcino, a big and powerful wine that is outstanding drinking. We have a mix of Brunello from the higher areas of Montalcino, which tend to be more elegant and savoury as well as some wines from the lower, southern slopes that tend to be a little darker and a little bigger. Vino Nobile di Montepulciano is an elegant wine that is wonderful drinking from the nearby town of Montepulciano, and the Rosso wines from both villages are lovely, light and refreshing reds that are a delight to drink.

### Tuscan Blends - the 'Super Tuscans'

On a recent trip to Italy we fell in love with the Super Tuscans. These wines are the misfits that don't follow the rules of the Sangiovese DOC and DOCG, led by the creative winemakers who started out replicating Bordeaux style blends from the coastal flats of Bolgheri to a whole new generation of winemakers across Tuscany experimenting with blending their native Sangiovese with international varieties like Cabernet, Syrah and Merlot. These tend to be darker and bigger wines than typical Italian red wines, but they are so, so interesting that you have to give them a try.

## Cabernet Sauvignon & Blends

*Another of the great red wine varieties of the world, emanating from Bordeaux in France and quickly spreading over the past 50 years to the new wine regions of Australia, California, South Africa and South America. These wines are bigger, darker reds, albeit they tend to have a little more elegance and structure than Shiraz. Tannins and acidity can be high, and its fruit profile tends to be blackcurrant, black cherry with a bit of herbaceousness. It is often blended with Merlot to soften the tannin profile. The high tannins and acidity enables Cabernet to age beautifully over time.*
