Riesling & Friends

Riesling is undoubtedly one of the great wine grapes of the world. It offers excellent value for money, speaks of place and vintage and only gets better with age. While styles and levels of residual sugar can vary significantly, when made well, the acid in the wine should balance this, meaning that it still finishes bright, fresh and clean. In addition to our Rieslings, you will also find examples of Grüner Veltliner, Gewürztraminer, Silvaner and Picpoul.

Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon & Chenin Blanc

As the tidal wave of cheap and cheerful New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc begins to recede, we are left to enjoy the original expressions of Sauvignon Blanc from the Loire Valley, as well as a range of elegant wines from across the New World with barely a hint of passionfruit! In addition, we explore local examples of Sauvignon Blanc blended with Semillon, contrast Semillon from the Hunter Valley with those of the Barossa & Margaret River, and list both local and French Chenin Blanc with varying levels of residual sugar.

Pinot Gris, Grigio & Blanc

These cousins of the Pinot Noir grape all produce lovely, refreshing white wines when made well. While Gris and Grigio are produced from the same grape, it is more than just the translation that should distinguish the two - the French Gris tends to be a larger, richer wine that typically sees time in oak, whereas the medium bodied Italian Grigio offers a nice balance of fruit and acid, with Pinot Blanc/Bianco lighter again. Thanks to Kathleen Quealy, who introduced the varietal to Australia, our cooler climate regions offer expressions in both styles.

Chardonnay

This classic white grape is one of the most planted around the world, and there's no wonder why given the breadth of styles it is able to produce. In its home of Burgundy, the full spectrum of wines are available from Chablis with its' un-oaked, high acid and flinty minerality, to the richer, honeyed wines from Meursault, and everything in between. In Australia today, the pendulum has swung back from the pursuit of heavily oaked, intense fruit forward wines to more classic wines that emphasise the juice more than the way it's been handled.

Nebbiolo

Nebbiolo is the classic red grape from the Piedmont region of Italy that has a long history of producing some of the finest wines in the world. It is a delicate grape that, like Pinot Noir, is slow to ripen, so it needs favourable slopes and lots of sun to reach its ripened state before the autumn fogs and lower temperatures arrive. In addition to the three key Nebbiolo wines of the region - Langhe Nebbiolo, Barolo and Barbaresco, we have sourced examples from the the lesser known regions in the north of Piedmont and from the Valtellina in Lombardia. And while there is limited Nebbiolo grown successfully outside of Piedmont, we have sourced a few examples from a couple of Australian Nebbiolo pioneers.

Sangiovese

Like Italy, Spain has an incredibly diverse geography and climate and as a result, a huge number of wine varietals, many of which offer fantastic value when compared with the wines of France and Italy. Our journey of discovery with Spanish wines is in its infancy, but we start with a number of tempranillo wines sourced from two of Spain's most well-known red wine regions - Ribera del Duero (where the varietal is referred to as Tinto Fino) and Rioja in the north of Spain. As well as our Australian examples, we introduce Touriga, one of the key varietals of Portugal, and our Greek wines.

Shiraz & Syrah

Much like Gris and Grigio, these two words, while describing the same varietal, have come to be more indicative of style. Finding its historic home in the vineyards of Northern Rhône, Syrah more commonly exhibits a peppery, earthy and a slightly lighter style than the Shiraz produced in the New World which tends to be more fruit forward.

Classic Australian Red Blends

While blending varietals is not a new thing, there are a handful of combinations that have become Australian icons in their own right.

Many of the Northern Rhône Syrah benefit from a touch of Viognier to soften their tannic expression, but iconic producers such as Clonakilla have made this a staple in their repertoire.

Legend has it that Hunter Valley winemakers in the 1950s and 1960s added Shiraz to their Pinots because they believed that's what the French did. While it has had its moment out of the spotlight, winemakers like Sarah Crowe at Yarra Yerring are part of its renaissance.

Finally, a blend unique to Australia, the powerful combination of Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon makes for a great wine to enjoy with red meat, and we have assembled a number of classics from each of the great red wine regions of Australia.

Merlot & Malbec

Merlot, albeit much maligned in the film *Sideways*, has typically been a blending agent, but there are a number of stand alone examples that are lovely, soft, luscious wines. And for those not familiar with the wines of Bordeaux, the wines of the Right Bank chateaus are typically Merlot dominant wines.

Similarly Malbec, which emanated in Bordeaux as a blending agent, but emerged in the Mendoza region of Argentina as a single varietal wine, is now appearing in Australia as a single varietal too. If you like juicy and fruity wines that aren't too tannic, then maybe it is time to give Malbec a try.
